Parenting the Transgender Child and Adolescent

Raising a transgender child isn't something anyone is prepared for and it can be a daunting prospect. This workshop will help parents learn more about gender identity and parenting children & teenagers who no longer identify with their ascribed gender. Carol will focus on the different roles & challenges fathers, mothers, and siblings experience and how to overcome them. Carol will also discuss various subjects experienced across child and adolescent-hood such as toileting, crushes, puberty, suppression and managing hurtful comments from their peers and other adults.

Parenting the Adopted Child

Adoption is a lifelong commitment requiring empathy, energy, patience, and a sense of humour. It can be a very difficult adjust for some families, but the reward when transforming a child's life forever, and building a happy fulfilled family is worth it. In this workshop, Carol will highlight the themes of belonging, identity, loyalty, yearning & wholeness that the adoptee's experience and how parents can facilitate these feelings in their adopted child. This workshop will consider adoption dynamics and different family & individual life cycle stages and consider the impact having an adopted child has on siblings and the wider family, as well as how these individuals can contribute to the feeling of connectedness for the adoptee.
