




Dear Principal of Primary and Secondary Schools in Shatin,

Project Smart Rider kicked off in 2016 by Shatin Police District to raise the awareness of safe cycling by engaging different sectors of the community, as well as organizing a series of safe-cycling trainings to students in Shatin. Smart Rider 2016 concluded in November with the largest safe-cycling training successfully held which also set a new Guinness World Record.

To achieve "Zero Accidents", Shatin Police District will continue to work hand-in-hand with our partners to promote cycling safety and extend the spirit of Smart Rider. Smart Rider 2017 will organize the following events:

1. **Basic Cycling Safety Training** - qualified basic safe-cycling training provided to students of the secondary and primary schools in Shatin. (30 students per class)
2. **"Smart Rider +"** - a half-day cycling practical session on cycling track to enhance the techniques and knowledge of Smart Riders who had completed the basic training. (30 students per session)
3. **Advanced Cycling Safety Training** - advanced safe-cycling training to qualified students who intend to improve their skills. (15 students per class)
4. **Celebration of the 20th Anniversary of the Establishment of the HKSAR** - Smart Rider is one of the invited participants of a large-scale road cycling carnival organized by Shatin District Office to celebrate the establishment of the HKSAR. Advanced Smart Riders will take part in a road cycling competition together with hundreds of professional cyclists, whilst Junior Smart Riders can also participate in a bicycle parade in Shatin town center. (Scheduled in Nov 2017. Priority will be given to Smart Riders who have completed "Smart Rider +" and the advanced training. Details of the carnival will be announced in due course.)
